## Three Days in June

- **The book opens with a question: “People don’t tap their watches anymore; have you noticed?” How does Gail explore the question of timekeeping as she describes the aspects of her life that are fleeting and the aspects that endure?**
- **What were your first impressions of Max? On their wedding day, were Max and Gail a good fit? How did your perceptions of their marriage shift as the details unfolded?**
- **How did you react to the novel’s carefully drawn portrayals of public appearance and the rituals associated with weddings? Is a perfect wedding a predictor of a happy marriage?**
- **Over those three days in June, what does Gail lose, gain, or regain?**
